## ORDINANCE 9901 TOWN OF ROUND LAKE SNOWMOBILE ACCESS ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Round Lake do ordain as follows:

- 1. The intent of this ordinance is to provide a means for persons to travel by snowmobile from a residence of lodging within the limits of the Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin for the shortest distance that is necessary for a person to operate a snowmobile to the snowmobile route or trail that is closest to that residence.
- 2. This ordinance is adopted as authorized under s. 350.18 (3) (a) .
- 3. This ordinance designates roadways or shoulders of all <u>Town Roads</u> for snowmobile travel by persons residing in or staying at a lodging establishment within the Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin to travel for the shortest distance that is necessary to reach the snowmobile trail or route that is closest to that residence or lodging establishment and is subject to the following conditions:
  - a. The speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour while operating on all Town of Round Lake roads and streets. Note: State Law restricts snowmobile speed to 10 mph within 150 feet of a dwelling between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m..
  - b. Snowmobiles shall operate on the extreme right side of the roadway and travel with the flow of traffic.
  - c. Snowmobiles are to be operated in single file.
  - d. Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way to all other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
  - e. Headlights shall be turned on and in working order at all times while operating on the roadway or shoulder.
  - f. Snowmobilers violating any of the above conditions would be subject to the underlying violation of illegally operating on the roadway.
- 4. Snowmobilers travel at their own risk and the Town of Round Lake will not be liable for any damages or injuries to snowmobilers occurring in the Town of Round Lake.
- 5. The Sawyer County Sheriff's Department is hereby designated as the law enforcement agency responsible for enforcing the provisions of this ordinance.
- 6. The penalty for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is the same as listed in s. 350.11 (1) (a), Wis. Stats., as adopted by reference.
- 7. This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law and shall repeal and replace all snowmobile access ordinances heretofore enacted by the Town of Round Lake.
