SNOWMOBILE ROUTE ORDINANCE
ORDINANCE 2013-01

The Town Board of the Town of Round Lake do ordain the following:

- 1.) That the following named roads in the Town of Round Lake, Sawyer County, Wisconsin shall be designated as snowmobile routes between those areas posted as such with snowmobile route signs:
 - a.) Callahan Lake Road – Start at CTH “B” between signs for approximately .25 miles.
 - b.) Chief River Road – Route begins approximately one (1) mile north of Tiger Cat Road and travels east and west between route signs for approximately 0.5 miles.
 - c.) Echo Point Road – Start at Tiger Cat Rd. for approximately 0.4 miles.
 - d.) Louie’s Landing Road – Start at FR 164 to Louie’s Landing restaurant and bar for approximately 0.2 miles.
 - e.) Moose Lake Road (FR 164) – Route off CTH “S” for approximately 0.3 miles to snowmobile trail.
 - f.) Phipps Fire Lane – from Lenroot Town line to Lenroot Town line.
 - g.) Tiger Cat Dam Road – for approximately .2 miles from boat landing to trail 18.
 - h.) FR 320 from Hwy 77 to FR 164 Moose Lake Road.
 - i.) FR 319 from FR 164 (Moose Lake Road) to Hunter town line.
 - j.) Moose Lake Road (FR 164) from 319 to 320.
 - k.) Moose Lake Rd. (FR164) from Trail 5 east 0.7 miles to Virgin Timber Resort Driveway as marked with posted route signs.
 - l.) Forest Road 174 –from (FR164) to Winter Town Line
- 2.) The speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour while operating on all Town of Round Lake roads and streets. Note: State Law restricts snowmobile speed to 10 mph within 150 feet of a dwelling between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- 3.) Snowmobiles shall operate on the extreme right side of the roadway and travel with the flow of traffic.
- 4.) Snowmobile are to be operated in single file.
- 5.) Snowmobile operators shall yield the right-of-way to all other vehicular traffic and pedestrians.
- 6.) Headlights shall be turned on and in working order at all times while operating on the roadway or shoulder.
- 7.) Snowmobilers violating any of the above conditions would be subject to the underlying violation of illegally operating on the roadway.
- 8.) Snowmobilers travel at their own risk and the Town of Round Lake will not be liable for any damages or injuries to snowmobilers occurring in the Town of Round Lake.

- 9.) The Sawyer County Sheriff's Department is hereby designated as the law enforcement agency responsible for enforcing the provisions of this ordinance.
- 10.) The penalty for violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance is the same as listed in s. 350.00 (1) (a), Wis. Stats., as adopted by reference.
- 11.) This Ordinance shall be effective upon passage and publication as provided by law and shall repeal and replace all snowmobile route ordinances heretofore enacted by the Town of Round Lake.
