

2018 PROPOSED BUDGET MEETING
THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2017

The public hearing on the Town of Round Lake 2018 proposed budget was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Chairperson Hanson. Present were Supervisors: Wilson, Karns, Schara, and Haak. Also present were Clerk McCoy, Treasurer Palya, and Fire Chief Schmidt, and 2 audience members. Total town residents including board, clerk and treasurer (9)

A brief overview of budget and reserve accounts was provided by Clerk noting that the town borrowed \$100,000.00 for Fire Station One addition after the proposed budget was published so indebtedness year end 2017 will be \$100,000.00. Small levy increase (\$1,883.00) allowed as per levy limit formula.

Budget Hearing adjourned at 6:35 p.m.

SPECIAL MEETING OF THE ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF ROUND LAKE, SAWYER
COUNTY, THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2017

Chairperson Hanson called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. The same electors present at the budget hearing attended the town elector meeting.

- 1.) To set compensation of elected town officials for the term of office beginning April 2018 through April 2020 pursuant to Section 60.10 (1) (b) of Wis. Statutes. Motion by Karns that (2 Supervisor seats up for election April, 2017) wage remain at current rate \$465.07 per month, eliminating the cost of living provision for these seats: Second by Wilson. Motion failed 4 in favor, 4 opposed, 1 abstention. (Supervisor Haak). Current compensation amount \$465.07 will continue to be increased yearly based on Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase used by Social Security as per 2016 motion.
- 2.) To adopt the 2017 town tax levy to be paid in 2018 pursuant to Section 60.10 (1) (a) of Wisconsin Statutes. Motion by Kathy McCoy, seconded by Marilyn Karns, to adopt the 2017 town levy of \$ 335,000 to be paid in 2018. Motion carried.
