1. Chairperson Kay Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

2. Approval of Agenda passed with a motion by Sandy, second by Denny.
3. Approval of Minutes April 27, 2011 meeting passed with a motion by Denny, second by Tom
3. Public recognition: Present were Sue Niemann, Gary Karns, Paul Picchietti, Bill Czeskleba
4. Discussed the restoration of the land surrounding the Moose Lake Bridge
  - Review Construction Drawings – **Ben** led the general review. Plan commission can present alternatives to the Town Board who would have to approve any additional costs. We can't do anything at the site until the State is finished with the project.
  - Review Watercraft Launching and Portage Proposals – **Ben** will check on an alternate site to meet Hayward Fly Fishing's access request: **Tom** will check on improving the access for canoe/kayak addressing rock removal.
  - Review Parking Proposals – Gary K. felt parking could be expanded to the other side of the bridge. **Pat** will follow up with fire dept. regarding allowance for dry hydrant access.
  - Review Native American Interests – **Kay** will follow up with LCO plan commission and historical/cultural tribal members.
  - Review Historical Society Sign Location – **Kay** will address the sign location with the LCO tribal members.
  - Review Additional Amenity Additions – Additional benches, flower boxes after site issues are resolved
  - Review Site Restoration Plans – **Denny** will follow up with Sawyer County regarding Hwy S design plan. **Sandy** will follow up with Town of Round Lake snowplow pattern.
  - Review Modernizing Powerline Crossing Conditions – **Kay** will get info on Town property lines. Question as to whether power company easement can be passed on to the Town.
  - Review Sign Organization – Fire Dept signs will need to be changed.
  - Review Environmental Corridor Designation Status
  - Review Designation as a Fishing Bridge – DNR paid for the snowmobile/ATV extension. Could be used for fishing if no conflicts are identified by DNR.
