Town Hall and Moose Lake Bridge

1. Chairperson Kay Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m.

2. Approval of Agenda passed with a motion by Sandy, second by Tom.
3. Approval of Minutes May 25, 2011 Meeting passed with a motion by Sandy, second by Denny
4. Public recognition: Present were Sue Niemann, Bill Czeskleba
5. Conditional Use Application: Thompson Sand & Gravel c/o Tom Thompson. Part of the SW ¼ NW ¼, S12, T 41N, R 8W: Parcel 2302 aka Hwy 77 Gravel Pit. Volume 423 Records page 246. 11.6 acres total. Property is zoned Forestry One. Permit is desired for the three (3) year renewal of conditional use permit #88-011 for the location/operation of a non-metallic mineral extraction, including a rock crusher and hot mix plant, which was approved at public hearing on July 18, 1988 and renewed most recently on July 18, 2008.
