

The Town of Round Lake Plan Commission  
Minutes: July 25, 2012  
Town Hall

1. Chairperson Kay Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.  
Present were members: Joe Dwyer, Denny Picchietti, Pat Feldner, and Sandy Schara
2. Approval of Agenda: passed with a motion by Denny, second by Sandy
3. Approval of Minutes May 30, 2012 meeting: passed with a motion by Joe, second by Sandy
4. Public recognition: No discussion on topics not on the agenda. No attendees present.
5. Discuss topics:
  - a. Denny's email address is now [NorthernExposure@centurylink.net](mailto:NorthernExposure@centurylink.net)
  - b. Review of proposed changes to the Shoreland-Wetland Ordinance presented by Kay. The hearing is scheduled for 8/17.
  - c. Reconstruction county highway S scheduled for 2014 presented by Sandy. Denny will contact Northern WI Based Engineers regarding compliance with the Rustic Road designation.
  - d. Amended Sawyer County cell tower ordinance has been distributed to members. Changes approved at the Sawyer County Zoning and Conservation Committee meeting on 7/11 was presented by Kay.
  - e. Grants are available from the Environmental Impact Fund for projects that enhance the quality of life for Sawyer County residents and visitors. Since the applications are due 8/1, we will consider applying for a grant next year.
  - f. There are problems with trash and late night noise at the Tiger Cat Dam. Since there is no Town curfew the Sheriff's department can not help. Sandy will pursue the possibility of posting a sign listing a closure time that could be enforced.
6. Project discussion:
  - a. Sandy presented information on the Teal Lake cell tower. Norvado is revising their plan to include 2 shorter towers in Spider Lake Township. After these are finalized Norvado plans to work south into our area. Sandy will continue to work with them and they know that the Town of Round Lake is very interested.
  - b. Joe will contact Ethel Richter regarding the date for the Moose Lake Park dedication.
  - c. Pat was did not receive comments on the fire protection education piece from Fire Chief Mike Schmidt. Sandy will follow-up with him at the next town board meeting. It was planned to be used along with other information material to be handed out by fire fighters and EMTs at the Moose Lake Festival. Pat will revise when comments are received and check whether it might be included with the annual tax letter to residents.
  - d. Denny is working on a map of the Rustic Roads for use by the Visitors and Convention Bureau and Chamber of commerce.
7. Meeting Adjourned at 8:35 PM on a motion by Sandy, second by Pat. The next meeting will be September 26, 2012.
