

The Town of Round Lake Plan Commission
Minutes: May 30, 2012
Town Hall

1. Chairperson Kay Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
Present were members: Ben Nieman, Tom Kersten, Joe Dwyer, Denny Picchiatti, Pat Feldner, Sandy Schara (joining late)
2. Approval of Agenda: passed with a motion by Joe, second by Denny
3. Approval of Minutes March 28, 2012 meeting: passed with a motion by Joe, second by Kay
4. Public recognition: No discussion on topics not on the agenda. Sue Nieman attending.
5. Conditional Use Permit: Dale Mrotek. Personal representative of Helen Mrotek Estate; Monarch Paving, Lessee. The SW ¼ NW ¼, and the W ½ SW ¼, and that part of the E ½ SW ¼ lying west of State Hwy 77, S1, T 41N, R8W; Parcels .7.1, .9.1, .10.1, .11.1, and .12.4. Volume 543 Records Page 414, Volume 552 Page 437, Volume 659 Page 177, Volume 629 Page 324; Document #362-154 and Doc# 377795. 154.44 acres total. Property is zoned Forestry One. Permit is desired for the three (3) year renewal of conditional use permit #89-0005 for the location/operation of a non-metallic mineral extraction, including a rock crusher and bituminous plant, which was approved at public hearing on June 16, 1989 and renewed most recently on June 19, 2009. Michael Burns represented Monarch Paving answering questions relating to buffers and hours of operation. Motion to approve the conditional use permit made by Pat, second by Denny - Approved
6. Discuss projects: **Kay reminded members to submit a list of projects they worked on in 2011 including the related goals and objectives**
Kay reported that she has been contacted by The Quiet Lakes Committee regarding a possible site for a communications tower. The Quiet Lakes Committee is currently protesting the Teal Lake location. Sandy will be contacting the Norvado rep. Kay and Sandy will be attending an open meeting on the communication tower on 6/27 at the Spider Lake Town Hall. Ben suggested that the 2 Town Plan Commissions might work together with the Quiet Lakes Committee on this issue. Sandy will follow-up.
Ben – is on the County advisory committee for the WI Land Information Project which will be working on the key parcel ownership piece. He will work towards getting the Town of Round Lake to the top of the list.
Pat – continuing to work on the fire safety objectives. A handout relating to access for fire and rescue equipment as well as protecting homes from wildfires has been prepared. Mike Schmidt is reviewing. It is hoped that this would be handed out by the fire department at the Moose Lake Festival.
Tom – reported that the dock is in at Chief River Boat landing and being used. The purchase of land on Mud Lake by the Bayfield Regional Conservancy Land Trust has not been completed as the purchase price has not been agreed to. He will let them know that the Plan Commission supports this effort.
Denny – continues to work with the VCB to develop maps of the Rustic Roads in Sawyer counts.
Joe – continues to work on goals relating to the Public Trust Document, personal and public property rights
Kay – will be serving on a committee to coordinate Sawyer County Shoreline regulations because of the new State Law 170
