

The Town of Round Lake Plan Commission
Minutes: August 31, 2011
Town Hall

1. Filling in for Chairperson Kay Wilson, Sandy Schara called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.
Present were members: Denny Picchietti, Tom Kersten, Ben Niemann, Joe Dwyer, Pat Feldner,
2. Approval of Agenda: passed with a motion by Ben, second by Tom.
3. Approval of Minutes July 27, 2011 meeting: passed with a motion by Joe, second by Denny
4. Public recognition: Present were Bill Czeskleba, Sue Niemann, Ethel Richter, Jan Stapleton
5. Public communications and info: Added brochures – Sawyer Co Record article on Rustic Road approval (Denny will bring next meeting)
6. Discuss the restoration of the land surrounding the Moose Lake Bridge: Ben presented a conceptual drawing for the landscape and restoration of the Horsefly Battle view/sign and landscaping around the new parking lot and river access. These plans will be presented to the MLIA at the Sept. 3rd meeting. Issues still to be resolved are: ongoing maintenance of the site, allowance for snowplowing and positioning of boulders, any changes to Co S road location when reconstructed (Denny following up), professional input into planting/landscape design, positioning of the Bear bench. Ethel indicated that the Historical Society would like to participate in the dedication ceremony and the Tribe should also be involved.
7. Discussion on current projects:
Denny – Will meet with Gary K. to order the Rustic Road signs and determine placement. She will also work with the other affected Towns.
Sandy – No response from her letter to Verizon about additional Town sites available. She felt there is now more emphasis on broadband availability than cell phones. Bass Lake Town Supervisor, Phil Nies, will be rescheduled for a presentation the Town Board on their park. This information will help in developing a park/pavilion at the Town Hall.
Pat – Working with Mike Schmidt on a check off list for property owners on exterior property fire protection and access, possible to be sent with the tax letter.
Tom – Continues to work on boat landing development, repair and handicap accessibility.
Joe – Continues to researching WI Public Trust Document as it pertains to private property rights goals.
Ben – Continue work on the Moose Lake Bridge restoration project.
8. Motion by Tom, second by Ben to have the Town Board consider declaring this site to be a “Cultural Park”.
