

The Town of Round Lake Plan Commission Special Meeting  
Minutes: May 29, 2013

- 1.) Call to order @ 6:30 p.m. In attendance: Kay Wilson, Denise Picchietti, Joe Dwyer, Ben Niemann, Tom Kersten and Pat Feldner
- 2.) Amended Agenda approved on a motion by Denise, second by Ben
- 3.) Minutes April 24, 2013 meeting approved on a motion by Kay, second by Tom
- 4.) Public recognition and three minute discussion per individual – No discussion
- 5.) Conditional Use Permit: A-1 Plumbing, Heating, and Excavating Inc. (Joan Pit) c/o Bart Vitcenda. The SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , S11, T41N, R 8W; Parcel 4.1 and part of the SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NW  $\frac{1}{4}$  lying west of State highway 77, S12, T 41N, R 8W; Parcel 7.1. Doc# 384713. Property is zoned Forest One and has 60 acres total. Permit is desired for the location/operation of non-metallic mineral extraction including a rock crusher.  
No reclamation plan was available at this time. Sawyer Co has been hired to complete this work but was unable to meet the deadline due to a change in personnel. Bart presented a letter from Tim Seidl (Assistant Conservationist, Sawyer County Zoning and Conservation Department) which assures that a reclamation plan that meets or exceeds all standards set forth by NR135 will be completed prior to the Town Board meeting June 13, 2013. The pit will be developed in small increments. The buffer of trees will remain from the existing house to the road. There is no fracking sand at this site.  
In a motion by Pat, second by Tom, the conditional use permit for the development of this new pit was approved as it is consistent with existing pits in the area and the future land use plan. This approval is contingent on there being an acceptable reclamation plan presented to the Town Board at the June 13, 2012 meeting.
