Our next class is Saturday, April 27th from 8:30am-12:30pm at Round Lake Town Hall, 11037 N County Road A. Cost is \$25 per person.

While we are blessed with amazing beauty all around us, it can take the ambulance 30 minutes to reach us, if not longer on the trails.

If your loved one quits breathing and goes into cardiac arrest, absent CPR, likelihood of survival is low with our ambulance arrival times.

You can double their chance of survival by starting CPR immediately.

The CPR / AED class teaches you (1) How to give CPR, including chest compressions and rescue breaths; and (2) How to use an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).
