Notice to voters: if you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initialed by two (2) election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initialed by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials (see end of ballot for initials).

Ballot form with columns: General Instructions, Democratic Party Primary (cont.), Republican Party Primary (cont.). Includes sections for Party Preference, Democratic Party Primary, and Republican Party Primary with various office positions and candidates.

Democratic Party Primary Continues at top of next column. Republican Party Primary continues at top of next column. Libertarian Party Primary begins on back of ballot.
Page 1 of 2-sided ballot. Ballot continues on other side. ->
