Minutes of the Town of Round Lake Regular Board Meeting May 9, 2024

Present: Chairman Rolfe Hanson and Supervisors, Dan Palmer, Kay Wilson, Scott Verbeck, and Jim Strandlund. Also present in person: Treasurer Vickie Palya, Clerk Kathy McCoy, and 16 in person audience members.

- 1.) Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. with the pledge of allegiance.
- 2.) Certification of Meeting Posting.

Clerk McCoy certified that meeting agenda had been posted as required on May 4, 2024. Clerk requested addition to agenda; approval of Operators License Mattie Lynn BoFFo May 10, - June 30, 2024. Item added to Clerks report.

- 3 Approval of Minutes: Town Board Meeting April 11, 2024 and Special Joint Meeting Town Board / Plan Commission May 3, 2024. Public Hearing April 11, 2024 Travis Butterfield Nonmetallic Mining License. Motion by Wilson/ Strandlund to approve the listed minutes as printed: Motion carried.

- 5.) Monthly Recycling Card Drawing. Carl Beckman's name was drawn. He is awarded a free recycling punch card for use at the town recycling center.
- 6.) Bid Opening and Possible awarding Crack Sealing. Clerk McCoy noted prior to bid opening that only half of Moose Lake Road would be done due to receipt of STP grant \$907,865.00 to redo the older 2.5 miles of the road. Three bids received all with required certificates of insurance: Seal Tech Inc. Total cost 67,983 Total lb.'s. 23,347. Fahrner Asphalt Sealers LLC Total cost 97, 018.56 Total lb.'s 31,914. Superior Sealers LLC Total cost 77,295.00 Total lb.'s 30,918. Motion by Palmer/Strandlund to accept Superior Sealers LLC bid (minus Moose Lake Road): Motion carried.

- 9.) Land Use Plan Commission Report: Ginny Chabek. Including report from onsite information gathering session on Proposed Mosquito Brook Subdivision by Dave Kafura and Dave Neuswanger.

Chair Chabek reported that the committee recommended approval of Shaw – Timberdoodle Subdivision – Mr. Scheffler will designate Lots 1 & 2 (East side) build on north side only. Committee recommended approval of both Subdivision plats for The Preserve at MBF- Jeremy Hill Phase 2 and 3. Mr. Neuswanger reviewed the written report he had provided to the board related to the property. Committee also recommended denial of proposed Sawyer County Zoning Ordinance proposed amendment to Section 4.26 #2. (Avoid User Conflicts). Commission member Kayler has been working on new survey for the Town and will present information to

the Town Board at June 13th, 2024 meeting. (This would be a comprehensive town survey including/ but not limited to ATV/UTV use).

10.) Motion by Verbeck/ Wilson to approve the Subdivision Plat Phase 3 The Preserve at MFL LLC Jeremy Hill consisting of 19 lots including 5 out lots: Motion carried.

- 13.) Approval / Disapproval: Sawyer County Zoning Ordinance Amendment to Section 4.26 #2 Storage Shed Exemption is not allowed in platted subdivisions unless Town Approval is granted. Motion by Wilson/ Hanson to deny the proposed Sawyer County Zoning Ordinance Amendment to Section 4.26 #2: Motion carried. (Wilson cited that it would create conflicts with other sections camping of ordinance).
- 14.) Road Report Update: Hanson Tiger Cat Boat Launch, Possible additional guard rails Twin Lake Road. Hanson reported that the construction at Tiger Cat Boat Launch was done intentionally to prevent pad erosion. Board provided with a sketch from the engineering firm as to what dock for the launch might look like. D.N.R. waterway grant may be possible for this. Supervisor Palmer will follow up on dock project including possible grant funding.

Engineering firm who did work for Twin Lake Road project felt additional guard rails where not needed. Line striping should help delineate roadway better. Laier has been working to get estimates for Pine Point dig outs — Paving on June agenda.
