Notice to voters: if you are voting on Election Day, your ballot must be initiated by two (2) election inspectors. If you are voting absentee, your ballot must be initiated by the municipal clerk or deputy clerk. Your ballot may not be counted without initials (see end of ballot for initials).

# TODAY'S PRIMARY IS A PARTISAN PRIMARY

At a partisan primary, you may only vote for candidates in one political party. This has been the case since the early 1900s.

**Therefore, when you vote today:**

**Choose ONE political party in which you will vote, and vote for individual candidates within that party**

**WARNING:** Voting in more than one political party may void your voting choices.
