

Minutes of the Town of Round Lake Special Meeting July 29, 2024.

Present: Chairman Rolfe Hanson and Supervisors, Dan Palmer, Kay Wilson, Jim Strandlund. Also present in person: Clerk Kathy McCoy, Treasurer Palya and 5 in person audience members.

- 1.) Chairman Hanson called the meeting to order at 7:30 PM.
- 2.) Certification of Meeting Posting. Clerk McCoy certificated that meeting had been posted as required on July 18, 2024.
- 3.) Discussion/ action Ordinance No. 2024-02 All-Terrain and Utility Terrain Vehicle Routes Ordinance. Clerk McCoy provided Board members with Original Ordinance provided to office by Supervisor Strandlund. And a copy of proposed changes / corrections by Clerk McCoy (Yellow Lined).

Plan Commission Chair – Chabek reported on recommendations/ review of Ordinance by Commission

- Accept all changes recommended by Town Clerk
- Recommended replacing Section V (B) signage – ATV and UTV routes will be clearly marked with signs designating the beginning and ending of routes, as well as other directions as needed. Routes must be signed in accordance with NR 64.12(7) (c), Wisconsin Administrative Code. ATV/UTV signage on all town roads routes will be the responsibility of Sawyer County Snowmobile and ATV Alliance, and the Town of Round Lake Road Department. This responsibility will be approved by the town of Round Lake Board of Supervisors. The Sawyer County Snowmobile and ATV Alliance will be required to work with the town of Round Lake Board of Supervisors to make sure all signage is complete and consistent throughout the Town. ATV/UTV posted signs may not be on all town roads but will be posted on Town roads entering the township.
- Section VII – (B) (3) – Recommend 35 MPH speed limit to be consistent with Town of Hayward.
- Section VII (B) (5) Replace with ATV/UTVs may not be operated on any town road without fully functional headlights, taillights, brake lights and a valid registration.
- Section VII (B) (C) Recommend ATV/ UTVs hour of operation will be 5 a.m. to midnight.
- Section X Recommend replacing “Accident “with Crash”. Recommend legal counsel review to ensure no town liability regarding crashes.

Motion by Palmer / Strandlund to approve Ordinance 2024-02 Final Draft (Clerks changes).
